

Box junction fines 2022

Read on to see what's new for '22 when it comes to driving. Currently, if you're caught in a yellow box junction, it's up to the police to hand you a £70 penalty. This is different in London and Cardiff, where local authorities are responsible for handing out penalties / fines . A box junction is outlined by a perimeter containing intersecting yellow lines in a grid pattern. We explain the rules, so you can stay safe and avoid a fine.

Previously, police could fine you for stopping in a yellow box junction anywhere in the country - but this rarely happened. But from June 2022, local authorities across the country have been able to issue
