Plug For Saint Lucia: What You Need To Know

North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Saint Lucia. North Americans device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Saint Lucia.

How to use plugs from United States of America in St. Lucia

You will need a step down voltage converter a device that can be plugged to 240 volts and it provides an outlet with 120 volts for your United States of America' device.



Saint Lucia

Saint Lucia uses power plugs and sockets of type G, with a standard voltage of 230 V and a frequency of 50 Hz. If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter.

Saint Lucia Electric Plug Types: PRIMARY Type G (240V)

The standard voltage in Saint Lucia is 230 volts at 50 Hz. This is higher than North American voltage (120V), so you may need a voltage converter for devices not designed for international use.
