Overview

Rapid growth in the deployment of solar, wind, and bio energy in recent years has led to Italy producing over 41% of its electricity from renewable sources in 2025, and adding 7.48 GW (7,480 MW) capacity in 2024. [4][5]. Renewable energy developed rapidly in Italy between 2005 and 2023, nearly doubling, and provided the country with a means of diversifying from its historical dependency on imported fuels. *Note: As of Final updated National Energy and Climate Plan (NECP) 2021-2030. Its revised targets reinforce a broader commitment to climate neutrality by 2050, with milestones for 40% . Researchers and NGOs have criticised the country's draft plan to reach EU 2030 climate targets for being vague about key topics such as phasing out oil, coal and gas, and expanding alternative energy sources like wind or solar power. Italy's largest source of clean electricity is solar (17%). Recognized as a leader in renewable energy, Italy is one of the top-ranking countries in terms of installed renewable energy capacity worldwide.

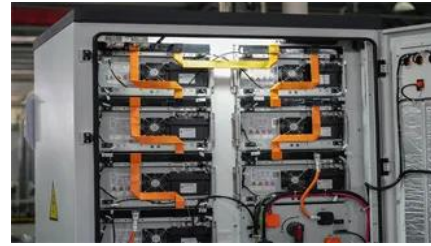
