A base station must be located at a high point or on a tower to maximize its radio transmission range. This elevation ensures that the radio waves can travel further, resulting in better connectivity between the mobile units in the field and the dispatch center. should be located in a low-lying area, free from potentially damaging high winds. does not require close proximity to the hospital that serves as the medical command center.
