Overview

Kazakhstan and China Energy Engineering Group have signed agreements to construct a 300 MW solar power plant in the Sauran district of Turkestan region, with an estimated investment of \$320mn and construction set for 2025-2026. The signing took place during the eighth meeting of the Kazakhstan-China Business . Recently, Energy China reached an important cooperation agreement with the government of Kazakhstan, officially signing an investment and power purchase agreement. The proposal was discussed at a meeting between Khatlon regional head Davlatali Said .
